## **ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

This matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge by authority of MCL 400.9 and MCL 400.37 upon Claimant's request for a hearing filed on November 30, 2010. After due notice, a telephone hearing was held February 2, 2012. Claimant personally appeared and provided testimony.

Prior to the closure of the hearing record, Claimant testified that he now understood the department's actions. Claimant requested the hearing because he believed he would have more income by the time of the hearing, and was unaware that all he needed to do was reapply, instead of requesting a hearing. Once Claimant heard the department's explanation and understood he was eligible to reapply, Claimant did not want to continue the hearing.

Therefore, it is not necessary for the Administrative Law Judge to decide the matter that was in dispute. Pursuant to MAC R 400.906 and 400.903, Claimant's hearing request is HEREBY DISMISSED, because Claimant is no longer aggrieved by a department action as it pertains to his SER benefits.
