ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge by authority of MCL 400.9 and MCL 400.37 upon the claimant's request for a hearing filed on January 24, 2012. After due notice, a telephone hearing was held on March 6, 2012 from Lansing, Michigan. Participants on behalf of Claimant included [REDACTED] Participants on behalf of Department of Human Services (Department) included [REDACTED] (Family Independence Specialist).

Prior to the closure of the hearing record, the parties have reached an agreement to resolve this matter. The Department shall rebudget and remove Claimant's stopped income for purposes of Claimant's Food Assistance Program (FAP) and Medical Assistance (MA) cases. Department further agrees to change Claimant's address on Bridges. Claimant acknowledged the above stipulation and expressed satisfaction with the terms of the agreement. Accordingly, Claimant indicated that she no longer believed it was necessary to continue with the hearing in this matter.

Because the parties have mutually reached an agreement to resolve this matter, there is no longer a pending dispute for the Administrative Law Judge to decide. Pursuant to Mich Admin Code R 400.906 and R 400.903, Claimant's hearing request is HEREBY DISMISSED as Claimant is no longer aggrieved by a department action as it pertains to her FAP and MA benefits.
