HEARING DECISION

This matter is before the undersigned Administ rative Law Judge pursuant to MCL 400.9 and MCL 400.37 following Claim ant's request for a hearing. After due notice, a telephone hearing was held on July 16, 2012, fr om Detroit, Michigan. Participants on behalf of Claimant included the Claimant. <u>ISSUE</u>

Did the Department properly close the claimant's MA deductible for not having met the deductible for three straight months?

FINDINGS OF FACT

The Administrative Law Judge, based on t he competent, material, and substantial evidence on the whole record, finds as material fact:

- On February 28, 2012, the department notified the cl aimant that her deductible MA benefits would close on April 1, 2012, for not having met the deductible for three months.
- 2. On March 13, 2012, the Claimant requested a hearing protesting the deductible and the closure of her deductible MA case.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Department policies are contained in the Br idges Administrative Manual (BAM), the Bridges Eligibility Manual (BEM), and the Reference Tables Manual (RFT).

Additionally, the claimant fa iled to meet the deductible requirements for three months consecutively, a fact not disputed by the claimant.

Redetermination

Redetermine eligibility for active deductib le cases at least every 12 months unless the group has not met its deductible within the past three months.

If a group has not met its deductible in at least one of the three calendar months before that month and none of the

members are QMB, SLM or AL Meligib le, Brid ges will automatically notify the group of closure. (BEM 545, p. 9).

DECISION AND ORDER

The Administrative Law Judge, based upon the above Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, and for the reasons stated on the record, finds that the Department ⊠ did act properly when it closed the claimant's MA. ☐ did not act properly when ∴

MAHS will not or der a rehearing or reconsideration on the Department's mo tion where the final decis ion cannot be implemented within 90 days of the filing of the original request. (60 days for FAP cases)

The Claimant may appeal the Decision and Order to Circuit Court within 30 days of the receipt of the Decision and Order or, if a timely request for rehearing was made, within 30 days of the receipt date of the rehearing decision.

Claimant may request a rehearing or reconsideration for the following reasons:

- A rehearing <u>MAY</u> be granted if there is newly discovered evidence that could affect the outcome of the original hearing decision.
- A reconsideration **MAY** be granted for any of the following reasons:
 - misapplication of manual policy or law in the hearing decision.
 - typographical errors, mathematical error, or other obvious errors in the hearing decision that effect the substantial rights of the claimant:
 - the failure of the ALJ to address other relevant issues in the hearing decision.
