In this case, on April 1, 2012, the Department

denied Claimant's application for benefits
closed Claimant's case for benefits
reduced Claimant's benefits

for:

Family Independence Program (FIP).
Food Assistance Program (FAP).
Medical Assistance (MA).
State Emergency Services (SER).

Claimant requested a hearing to disput ethe Department's action. Shortly after commencement of the hearing, Claimant testified that s/he now understood and accepted the actions taken by the Department. Claimant also testified that s/he did not wish to proceed with a hearing. The Department agreed to the dismissal of Claimant's hearing request. Pursuant to MAC R 400.906(1), Claimant's hearing request is hereby DISMISSED.

Based on the above discussion, it is O pursuant to MAC R 400.906(1).
