ISSUE

Did the Department properly calculate the claimant's MA deductible?

FINDINGS OF FACT


The Administrative Law Judge, based on t he competent, material, and substantial evidence on the whole record, finds as material fact:

- 1. On March 26, 2012, the departm ent sent a notice to the cl aimant that his MA would carry a deductible amount of \$542.00 per month beginning April 1, 2012.
- 2. On April 17, 2012 the clai mant requested a hearing to protest the deductible placed on his MA.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Department policies are contained in the Br idges Administrative Manual (BAM), the Bridges Eligibility Manual (BEM), and the Reference Tables Manual (RFT).

The Family Independence Program (FIP) was established pursuant to the Personal Responsibility and W ork Opportunity Reconciliation Act of 1996, Public Law 104-193,



At the hearing this Administrative Law Judge went over the claimant's MA budget that led to the deductible being place on his MA with the claimant and his attorney. The claimant is receiving \$970.00 per month in SSI benefits. From that is deducted a general exclusion of \$20.00 leaving \$950.00 per month as the claimant's countable income. When the claimant's protected income of \$408.00 is deducted, the result is a deductible of \$542.00 per month. This is the amount that the department lists as the claimant's deductible. (RFT 200, 240).

DECISION AND ORDER

The Administrative Law Judge, based upon the above Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, and for the reasons stated on the record, finds that the Department

did act properly when it calculated the claimant's MA deductible. properly when .	☐ did not act
Accordingly, the Department's AMP FIP FAP MA SDA SDA is AFFIRMED REVERSED for the reasons stated on the record.	CDC decision

NOTICE: Michigan Administrative Hearing Syst em (MAHS) may order a rehearing or reconsideration on either its own motion or at the request of a par ty within 30 days of the mailing date of this Dec ision and Order. MAHS will not or der a rehearing or reconsideration on the Department's mo tion where the final decis ion cannot be implemented within 90 days of the filing of the original request. (60 days for FAP cases)

The Claimant may appeal the Decision and Order to Circuit Court within 30 days of the receipt of the Decision and Order or, if a ti mely request for rehearing was made, within 30 days of the receipt date of the rehearing decision.

Claimant may request a rehearing or reconsideration for the following reasons:

- A rehearing **MAY** be granted if there is newly discovered evidence that could affect the outcome of the original hearing decision.
- A reconsideration **MAY** be granted for any of the following reasons:
 - misapplication of manual policy or law in the hearing decision,
 - typographical errors, mathematical error, or other obvious errors in the hearing decision that effect the substantial rights of the claimant:
 - the failure of the ALJ to address other relevant issues in the hearing decision.
