**CONSENT ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

This matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge pursuant to MCL 400.9 and MCL 400.37 following Claimant's request for a hearing. After due notice, a telephone hearing was held on October 22, 2012, from Detroit, Michigan. Participants on behalf of Claimant included Claimant. Participants on behalf of the Department of Human Services (Department) included [REDACTED] Assistance Payment Supervisor.

The Michigan Administrative Code R 400.903(1) provides as follows:


An opportunity for a hearing shall be granted to an applicant who requests a hearing because his claim for assistance is denied or is not acted upon with reasonable promptness, and to any recipient who is aggrieved by an agency action resulting in suspension, reduction, discontinuance, or termination of assistance.

In this case, on June 1, 2012, the Department approved Claimant for Medical Assistance (MA) coverage with a monthly \$560 deductible.

Claimant requested a hearing to dispute the Department's action. Shortly after commencement of the hearing, Claimant testified that she now understood and accepted the actions taken by the Department. Claimant also testified that she did not wish to proceed with a hearing. The Department agreed to the dismissal of Claimant's hearing request. Pursuant to Michigan Code R 400.906(1), Claimant's hearing request is hereby DISMISSED.
