The law pr ovides that disposition may be made of a contest ed case by s tipulation or agreed settlement. MCL 24.278(2).

In the present case, Claimant requested a hearing to dispute the Department's action. Soon after commencement of the hearing, the parties testified that they had reached a settlement concerning the disputed action. Consequently, the Department agreed to do the following: remove the sanction from Claimant's FIP and FAP cases and reinstate Claimant's FIP and FAP cases, effective August 1, 2012.

As a result of this settlement, Claimant no longer wish es to proceed with the hearing. As such, it is unnec essary for this Admi nistrative Law Judge to render a decis ior regarding the facts and issues in this case.

# **DECISION AND ORDER**

The Administrative Law Judge concludes that the Department and Claimant have come to a settlement regarding Claimant's request for a hearing.

### THE DEPARTMENT IS ORDERED TO DO THE FOLLOWING:

- 1. Remove the sanction from Claimant's FIP and FAP cases.
- 2. Initiate reinstatement of Claimant's FIP and FAP cases, effective August 1, 2012, if Claimant is eligible for FIP and FAP.
- 3. Issue FIP and FAP supplements, in accordance with Department policy.

The Claimant may appeal the Decision and Order to Circuit Court within 30 days of the receipt of the Decision and Order or, if a timely request for rehearing was made, within 30 days of the mailing date of the rehearing decision.
