HEARING DECISION

The law, MCL 24.278(2); MSA 3.560(178)(2) provides that a disposition may be made of a contested case hearing by stipulation or agreed settlement. In this case, a hearing request was filed by Claimant and was scheduled for October 4, 2012.

Prior to the beginning of a hearing record, on the day of the hearing, Claimant's [REDACTED] and authorized hearing representative stated they had trouble getting the [REDACTED] required because the account has been closed for a while and they did not know the [REDACTED]. She also stated that they have gotten verbal information from the [REDACTED] and are waiting for documentation to arrive. The Department of Human Services stated that they now realize Claimant was having difficulty getting verification of the [REDACTED] and will still accept the verification and process Claimant's application.

Accordingly, it is not necessary for the Administrative Law Judge to decide the matter that was in dispute. Pursuant to MAC R 400.906 and 400.903, claimant's/claimants' hearing request is HEREBY DISMISSED, because claimant is/claimants are no longer aggrieved by a Department action.

DECISION AND ORDER

Based upon the resolution of the dispute by agreement of the parties, it is ORDERED that the Department continue to process Claimant's Food Assistance Program (FAP) application and Claimant's hearing request is dismissed.
