**ORDER OF DISMISSAL**


This matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge pursuant to MCL 400.9 and MCL 400.37 following Claimant's request for a hearing. After due notice, an in-person hearing was held on August 9, 2012, in Inkster, Michigan. Participants on behalf of Claimant included [REDACTED]. Participants on behalf of the Department of Human Services (Department) included [REDACTED].

The State Emergency Relief (SER) program is established by 2004 PA 344. The SER program is administered pursuant to MCL 400.10, *et seq.*, and by 1999 AC, R 400.7001 through Rule 400.7049. Department policies are found in the State Emergency Relief Manual (ERM)

ERM 101 instructs that SER applicants must "have an emergency which threatens health or safety and can be resolved through issuance of SER."

In this case, Claimant applied for SER relocation services. [REDACTED] testified that Claimant is no longer in an emergency situation, as Claimant obtained relocation funds from other agencies. Since an issuance of an SER payment would not resolve an emergency, Claimant's request is moot.

Based on the above discussion, it is ORDERED that this matter is DISMISSED.
