HEARING DECISION

This matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge pursuant to MCL 400.9 and MCL 400.37 following Claimant's request for a hearing. After due notice, a telephone hearing was held on October 10, 2012. Claimant appeared and testified.

ISSUE

Did the Department of Human Services properly close Claimant's Medical Assistance (MA) and Food Assistance Program (FAP) on August 31, 2012 because he failed to provide required verifications?

FINDINGS OF FACT

The Administrative Law Judge, based upon the competent, material, and substantial evidence on the whole record, including testimony of witnesses, finds as material fact:

1. Claimant was an ongoing recipient of Medical Assistance (MA) and Food Assistance Program (FAP) benefits. Claimant's certification period was to end on August 31, 2012.
2. On August 13, 2012, Claimant was sent a Verification Checklist (DHS-3503). The required verifications were due on August 23, 2012.
3. On August 29, 2012, the Department had not received the required verifications. The Department closed Claimant's case as of August 31, 2012. The Department sent Claimant notice of the closure.
4. On September 6, 2012, Claimant filed a hearing request.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Department policies are found in the Bridges Administrative Manual (BAM), the Bridges Eligibility Manual (BEM) and the Reference Tables Manual (RFT).

The Food Assistance Program (FAP) [formerly known as the Food Stamp (FS) program] is established by the Food Stamp Act of 1977, as amended, and is implemented by the federal regulations contained in Title 7 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR). The Department (formerly known as the Family Independence Agency) administers FAP pursuant to MCL 400.10, *et seq.*, and 1997 AACRS R 400.3001-3015

The Medical Assistance (MA) program is established by the Title XIX of the Social Security Act and is implemented by Title 42 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR). The Department (formerly known as the Family Independence Agency) administers the MA program pursuant to MCL 400.10, *et seq.*, and MCL 400.105.

At this hearing Claimant did not dispute that the verifications were not submitted until after closure of the cases. A detailed analysis of the evidence presented, applicable Department policies, and reasoning for the decision are contained in the recorded record. During the hearing Claimant was informed of the decision and the reasoning behind the decision.

DECISION AND ORDER

The Administrative Law Judge, based upon the above Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, and for the reasons stated on the record, finds that the Department of Human Services properly closed Claimant's Medical Assistance (MA) and Food Assistance Program (FAP) on August 31, 2012 because he failed to provide required verifications.

It is ORDERED that the actions of the Department of Human Services, in this matter, are UPHeld.
