ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge by authority of MCL 400.9 and MCL 400.37; upon claimant's request for a hearing filed on March 1, 2013. Claimant requested a hearing to protest the closure of her FAP case. After due notice, an in-person hearing was held on April 23, 2013. Claimant appeared and testified.

Prior to the closure of the hearing record, the parties reached an agreement to resolve this matter. The department agreed to initiate a redetermination and approval of Claimant's FAP case closure retro to the date the FAP case closed or her FAP benefits ended.

Claimant acknowledged the above stipulation and expressed satisfaction with the agreement.

Therefore, it is not necessary for the Administrative Law Judge to decide the matter that was in dispute. Pursuant to MAC R 400.906 and 400.903, claimant's hearing request is **HEREBY DISMISSED**, because claimant is no longer aggrieved by a Department action.
