DECISION AND ORDER ON REMAND FROM KENT COUNTY CIRCUIT COURT

This case is before an Administrative Law Judge of the Michigan Administrative Hearing System pursuant to an Order Remanding Matter For Agency Determination to Administrative Law J udge dated April 16, 2013, from the Honorable Rosemary E. Aquilina, Circuit Court J udge, Ingham County Circuit Court and purs uant to the provisions of MCL 400.9, MCL 400.37, MCL 400.43(a), MAC R 400.941 and MCL 24.201, et seq.

PROCEDUAL HISTORY

- 1. On January 16, 2013, a hearing was conducted by Administrative Law Judge Janice Spodarek.
- 2. On February 7, 2013, a Hearing Deci sion was generated and mailed in this case that reversed the determination of Claiman t's ineligibility for Medica id program benefits (MA) previously made by Respon dent, Department of Human Servic es, and ordered Respondent to make a dete rmination of eligibility based on nonmedical criteria, that a MA c ase would be opened by Respondent granting MA program benefits to Claimant from the date of application, including any retro months if eligible, and supplemental benefits.
- On February 15, 2013, the Michigan Ad ministrative Hearing System (MAHS) received Claimant's Motion for Recons ideration for Obvious Error Including Failure to Determine SDA and Retro MA-P, filed by Claimant's counsel of record.
- 4. Pending the processing of Claimant's Motion for Reconsideration for Obvious Error Including Failur e to Deter mine SD A and Retro MA-P referenced above, Claimant's attorney filed Cl aim of Appeal with the 30 th Judicial Circuit Court for the County of Ingham on March 6, 2013.

- On March 15, 2013, MAHS issued an Order Granting Request for Rehearing and Vacating Hearing Dec ision and Order. This Order vacated the decision m ailed on February 7, 2013, from the hearing conducted on January 16, 2013.
- On April 16, 2013 the Hon. Rosemary E. Aquilina, Circuit Court Judge for Ingham County, entered a Stipulat ed Order to Remand (Amended). Further, the Circuit Court did not retain jurisdiction of the matter, but dismides seed the petition for review.
- 7. On June 3, 2013, MAHS issued an Administrative Order After Remand, ordering Claimant's Motion for Reconsideration fo r Obvious Error Including Failure to Determine SDA and Retro-MA-P to be held in abeyance until the Department of Human Services determines whether Claimant meets the non-medical criteria for the Medicaid program. Further, MAHS would be scheduling a hearing for the limited purpose of reconsidering the issues raised in the Petition for Review once MAHS received the said determination from the Department of Human Services.
- 8. On June 5, 2013, MAHS mailed the Notice of Hearing to Claimant notifying her of the scheduled Rehearing on June 25, 2013.

DECISION AFTER REHEARING

This matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge pursuant to MCL 400.9, MCL 400.37, and Mich Admin Code Rule 400.909 upon an Order Granting Rehearing and Order Vacating a Hearing Decision generated by the assigned Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) at the conclusion of a hearing conducted on January 16, 2013, and mailed on February 7, 2013, in the above-captioned matter. The date for a new hearing having been assigned and due notice having been provided, a telephone hearing was conducted from Lansing, Michigan, on Joune 25, 2013. Participants on behalf of Claimant included Attorney Sarah Bouck and Interpreter Marta Herrera-Zamora. Participants on behalf of the Department of Human Services (Department) included Lead Worker Sally Wilson.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Department policies are found in the Bridges Administrative Manual (BAM), the Bridges Eligibility Manual (BEM), the Reference Tables Manual (RFT), and the State Emergency Relief Manual (ERM).

The Medic al Assistance (MA) program is est ablished by the Title XIX of the Socia I Security Act and is implemented by Title 42 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR). The Department of Human Services (formerly known as the Family Independ ence Agency) administers the MA pr ogram pursuant to MCL 400.10, et seq., and MC L 400.105.

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The State Disability Assistanc e (SDA) program, which provides financial ass istance for disabled persons, is established by 2004 PA 344. The Department of Human Services (formerly known as the Fa mily Independence Agenc y) admin isters the SDA program pursuant to MCL 400.10, et seq., and 2000 AACS, Rule 400.3151 through Rule 400.3180.

The law pr ovides that disposition may be made of a contest ed case by s tipulation or agreed settlement. MCL 24.278(2).

In the present case, Claimant requested a hearing to correct the previous Decis ion dated February 7, 2013, of the January 16, 2013, which failed to address the issue of SDA. Soon after commencement of the hearing, the parties testified that they had reached a settlement concerning the disputed action. Consequently, the Department agreed to grant Claimant's application for MA and SDA beginning March, 2012.

As a result, although this case was reman ded from the Circu it Court, the parties hav e reached a resolution and Claim ant no longer wishes to proceed with the hearing. A s such a full hearing is no longer necessary.

DECISION AND ORDER

The Administrative Law Judge concludes that the Department and Claimant have come to a settlement regarding Claimant's request for a hearing.

THE DEPARTMENT IS ORDERED TO DO THE FOLLOWING:

1. Grant Claimant's applications for MA dated 3/8/12 and SD A dated 8/13/12, and find Claimant eligible for MA and SDA effective March, 2012.


