**SETTLEMENT ORDER**

The law, MCL 24.278(2); MSA 3.560(178)(2) provides that a disposition may be made of a contested case hearing by stipulation or agreed settlement. In this case a hearing was conducted on March 5, 2013.

Prior to the end of the recorded record Claimant and the Department of Human Services agreed that their issues would be resolved by the Department putting Medical Assistance (MA) coverage on for Claimant beginning May 2010 upon a showing that Claimant had been determined disabled by Social Security Administration beginning in May 2010.

Since the claimant and the department have come to an agreement it is unnecessary for this Administrative Law Judge to make a decision regarding the facts and issues in this case.

**DECISION AND ORDER**

The Administrative Law Judge has determined that the Department of Human Services and Claimant have come to a settlement regarding Claimant's request for hearing in this case. Therefore it is ORDERED that the Department of Human Services put Medical Assistance (MA) coverage on for Claimant beginning May 2010 upon a showing that Claimant had been determined disabled by Social Security Administration beginning in May 2010, in accordance with this settlement agreement.
