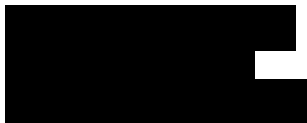

ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge in accordance with 7 CFR 273.16, MCL 400.9, MCL 400.37, and Michigan Admin Code, R 400.3130, on the Department of Human Services' (the Department's) request for hearing. The disqualification hearing was scheduled for April 25, 2013 pursuant to a Notice of Disqualification Hearing issued on March 22, 2013.

Section 78 of the Michigan Administrative Procedures Act, MCL 24.278(2), provides that a disposition may be made of a contested case hearing by stipulation, agreed settlement, consent order, waiver, default or other method agreed upon by the parties. In this case, on April 2, 2013, Respondent signed an Intentional Program Violation Repay Agreement. On that same date, Respondent requested a waiver of the disqualification hearing and, in doing so, acknowledged her understanding that she would be disqualified from the Food Assistance Program for a period of one year without a hearing.

Therefore, it is not necessary for the Administrative Law Judge to decide the matter that was in dispute. Pursuant to MCL 24.278(2), the Department's disqualification hearing request is **HEREBY DISMISSED**.

NOTICE: The Michigan Administrative Hearing System (MAHS) may order a rehearing or reconsideration on either its own motion or at the request of a party within 30 days of the mailing date of this Order of Dismissal. MAHS will not order a rehearing or reconsideration on the Department's motion where the final decision cannot be implemented within 90 days of the filing of the original request.

Claimant may appeal this Order of Dismissal to Circuit Court within 30 days of the receipt of the Order of Dismissal or, if a timely request for rehearing was made, within 30 days of the receipt date of the rehearing decision.
