ORDER AMENDING HEARING DECISION TO CORRECT FINDING OF FACTS

Following Claimant's request for a hearing, this matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge pursuant to MCL 400.9 and 400.37; 42 CFR 431.200 to 431.250; and 45 CFR 205.10. After due notice, a telephone hearing was held on October 2, 2014, from Lansing, Michigan. Claimant personally appeared and testified. Participants on behalf of the Department of Human Services (Department) included Assistance Payment Supervisor

At the conclusion of the hearing, a Hearing Decision was issued by Administrative Law Judge Vicki L. Armstrong and mailed on October 15, 2014 which is hereby **AMENDED** to correct the <u>Findings of Facts</u>. All Conclusions of Law contained in the original Hearing Decision dated October 15, 2014 remain unchanged and are incorporated herein by reference.

FINDINGS OF FACT

The Administrative Law Judge, based on the competent, material, and substantial evidence on the whole record, finds as material fact:

- (1) On May 20, 2014, Claimant filed an application for SDA benefits alleging disability.
- (2) On July 24, 2014, the Medical Review Team (MRT) denied Claimant's application for SDA. (Dept Ext A, pp 3-4).
- (3) On July 28, 2014, the Department sent Claimant notice that his SDA application was denied. (Hearing Summary).
- (4) On July 31, 2014, Claimant filed a request for a hearing to contest the Department's negative action.

- (5) Claimant has a history of a broken ankle and drainage from an open wound.
- (6) Claimant is a 54 year old man whose birthday is

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NOTICE OF APPEAL: A party may appeal this Hearing Decision in the circuit court in the county in which he/she resides, or the circuit court in Ingham County, within 30 days of the receipt date.

A party may request a rehearing or reconsideration of this Hearing Decision from the Michigan Administrative Hearing System (MAHS) within 30 days of the mailing date of this Hearing Decision, or MAHS may order a rehearing or reconsideration on its own motion.

MAHS may grant a party's Request for Rehearing or Reconsideration when one of the following exists:

- Newly discovered evidence that existed at the time of the original hearing that could affect the outcome of the original hearing decision;
- Misapplication of manual policy or law in the hearing decision which led to a wrong conclusion;
- Typographical, mathematical or other obvious error in the hearing decision that affects the rights of the client;
- Failure of the ALJ to address in the hearing decision relevant issues raised in the hearing request.

The party requesting a rehearing or reconsideration must specify all reasons for the request. MAHS will not review any response to a request for rehearing/reconsideration.

A request must be *received* in MAHS within 30 days of the date this Hearing Decision is mailed.
