**ORDER OF DISMISSAL PURSUANT TO
WITHDRAWAL OF HEARING REQUEST AT HEARING**


This matter is before the Michigan Administrative Hearing System upon Claimant's request for hearing made pursuant to MCL 400.9 and MCL 400.37, and Titles 7, 42, and 45 of the Code of Federal Regulations, which govern the administrative hearing and appeal process. After due notice, an in-person hearing was commenced on June 24, 2015, from Lansing, Michigan. Participants on behalf of Claimant included [REDACTED], the Claimant; [REDACTED] Attorney; and [REDACTED], Legal Clerk. Participants on behalf of the Department of Health and Human Services (Department) included [REDACTED], Assistant Attorney General (AAG); [REDACTED], AAG; [REDACTED], Hearing Coordinator; and [REDACTED], back-up Hearing Coordinator.

The hearing was requested to dispute the Department's action taken with respect to the Medicare Savings Program (MSP) program benefits. Shortly after commencement of the hearing, the parties confirmed that the MSP issue was resolved. Claimant's Attorney withdrew the MSP portion of the Request for Hearing.

As discussed on the record, Home Help was also mentioned in the body of Claimant's hearing request. This hearing was not set up to address the Home Help Services (HHS) issue with notice provided to all relevant parties for that case type. Claimant's hearing request will be forwarded for separate hearing proceedings regarding the HHS issue.

Pursuant to the withdrawal of the hearing request filed in this matter regarding the MSP program, the MSP portion of the Request for Hearing is, hereby, **DISMISSED**.
