**ORDER OF DISMISSAL PURSUANT TO
WITHDRAWAL OF HEARING REQUEST AT HEARING**

This matter is before the Michigan Administrative Hearing System upon Claimant's request for hearing made pursuant to MCL 400.9 and MCL 400.37, and Titles 7, 42, and 45 of the Code of Federal Regulations, which govern the administrative hearing and appeal process. After due notice, a telephone hearing was commenced on June 10, 2015, from Lansing, Michigan. Participants on behalf of Claimant included [REDACTED], the Claimant. Participants on behalf of the Department of Health and Human Services (Department) included [REDACTED], Hearing Facilitator and Eligibility Specialist (ES).

The hearing was requested to dispute the Department's lack of action with respect to the Food Assistance Program (FAP) and State Disability Assistance (SDA) program benefits. A February 27, 2015, Hearing Decision (MAHS Reg. No. 15-00843) ordered the Department to register and process Claimant's October 8, 2014, applications for FAP and SDA, issue supplemental payments to Claimant from the application date ongoing, and notify Claimant of its decision in writing. Shortly after commencement of the hearing, the ES confirmed that after the hearing request was filed, a help desk ticket was resolved and the FAP benefits, including supplemental payments, were issued to Claimant. Additionally, the ES testified that the morning of this hearing, she saw that the Medical Review Team had approved SDA benefits for Claimant on February 23, 2015. The ES processed and certified the SDA approval on June 10, 2015. Accordingly, SDA benefits, including supplemental payments, will be issued to Claimant.

Claimant confirmed that he has received the supplemental FAP payments and that the contested FAP issue has been resolved. Claimant also understood that the Department has now processed and certified the SDA approval; therefore the SDA benefits, including supplemental payments, will be issued. Accordingly, Claimant withdrew his Request for Hearing.

Pursuant to the withdrawal of the hearing request filed in this matter, the Request for Hearing is, hereby, **DISMISSED**.
