
**ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION FOR FILING
RESPONSE TO PETITIONER'S MOTION FOR SUMMARY JUDGMENT**

On October 29, 2015, [REDACTED], Assistant Attorney General (AAG), requested permission to file a response to the Motion for Summary Judgment filed by attorney [REDACTED], on October 19, 2015, on behalf of the Petitioner. [REDACTED] requested an extension to file a response to the Motion for Summary Judgment by November 4, 2015. In the request, [REDACTED] noted that her office did not receive the Motion until Friday, October 23, 2015, in the late afternoon, and that AAG McLean was unable to file a written response due to other filing deadlines and a hearing appearance on October 28, 2015. Responses to Motions must be filed within seven days; therefore it is determined that the request to extend time for filing a response to the Motion for Summary Judgment is timely filed. MAHS Administrative Rule 792.10104.

The request filed by AAG McLean is considered a request for action pursuant to MAHS Administrative Rule 115.

The undersigned Administrative Law Judge, having found good cause exists to extend the time for the filing of a response to the Motion for Summary Judgment, [REDACTED] shall have until November 4, 2015, to file the Department of Health and Human Services response.
