
**ORDER OF DISMISSAL PURSUANT TO
WITHDRAWAL OF HEARING REQUEST AT HEARING**

This matter is before the Michigan Administrative Hearing System upon Petitioner's request for hearing made pursuant to MCL 400.9 and MCL 400.37, and Titles 7, 42, and 45 of the Code of Federal Regulations, which govern the administrative hearing and appeal process. After due notice, a telephone hearing was commenced on January 25, 2016, from Detroit, Michigan. The Petitioner was represented by the Petitioner, [REDACTED]. The Department of Health and Human Services (Department) was represented by [REDACTED], Eligibility Specialist.

The hearing was requested to dispute the Department's action taken with respect to the Department's denial of full coverage Medical Assistance program benefits for Petitioner. Shortly after commencement of the hearing, Petitioner testified that she now understood the actions taken by the Department and that she had until this month January 2016 full coverage Medical Assistance and did not wish to proceed with the hearing. The Department's recent switching of the Petitioner from Full Coverage Medical Assistance to Emergency Services (ESO) was NOT addressed at this hearing; the Petitioner was advised to contact the Department to resolve that matter. The Request for Hearing dated August 27, 2015, was withdrawn. The Department agreed to the dismissal of the hearing request.

Pursuant to the withdrawal of the hearing request filed in this matter, the Request for Hearing is, hereby, **DISMISSED**.
