**ORDER OF DISMISSAL PURSUANT TO
WITHDRAWAL OF HEARING REQUEST AT HEARING**

This matter is before the Michigan Administrative Hearing System upon Petitioner's request for hearing made pursuant to MCL 400.9 and MCL 400.37, and Titles 7, 42, and 45 of the Code of Federal Regulations, which govern the administrative hearing and appeal process. After due notice, a three-way telephone hearing was commenced on January 13, 2015, from Detroit, Michigan. The Petitioner was represented by [REDACTED] the Petitioner's Authorized Hearing Representative (AHR). The Department was represented by [REDACTED], Assistance Payments Worker.


The hearing was requested to dispute the Department's action taken with respect to the granting of Emergency Services Only (ESO) benefits rather than granting of Full Medicaid coverage program benefits. Shortly after commencement of the hearing, Petitioner or Petitioner's Authorized Hearing Representative (AHR) testified that he had received the Department's November 18, 2015, Benefit Notice and was satisfied with the Department's correction granting Petitioner [REDACTED] full medical coverage; and he now understood the actions taken by the Department and did not wish to proceed with the hearing. The Request for Hearing was withdrawn. The Department agreed to the dismissal of the hearing request.

Pursuant to the withdrawal of the hearing request filed in this matter, the Request for Hearing is, hereby, **DISMISSED**.
