## ORDER OF DISMISSAL PURSUANT TO WITHDRAWAL OF HEARING REQUEST AT HEARING

This matter is before the Michigan Administrative Hearing System upon Petitioner's request for hearing made pursuant to MCL 400.9 and MCL 400.37, and Titles 7, 42, and 45 of the Code of Federal Regulations, which govern the administrative hearing and appeal process. After due notice, a telephone hearing was commenced on May 2, 2016, from Detroit, Michigan. The Petitioner was represented by the Petitioner, of Health and Human Services (Department) was represented by Independence Manager; and Regulations, Eligibility Specialist.

The hearing was requested to dispute the Department's action taken with respect to the Cash Assistance and Food Assistance Program (FAP) benefits. Shortly after commencement of the hearing, Petitioner testified that she now understood the actions taken by the Department and that she was receiving in Food Assistance, the maximum amount for a one-person group; and Petitioner had received an FAP supplement for all of 2015. Because she receives RSDI, she was not eligible for State Disability Assistance (SDA) Cash Assistance based on disability. It was also explained to Petitioner that she was not eligible for cash assistance for children who did not live with her. Based on this information, the Petitioner testified that she did not wish to proceed with the hearing. The Request for Hearing was withdrawn. The Department agreed to the dismissal of the hearing request.

Pursuant to the withdrawal of the hearing request filed in this matter, the Request for Hearing is, hereby, **DISMISSED**.
