ORDER OF DISMISSAL PURSUANT TO WITHDRAWAL OF HEARING REQUEST AT HEARING

This matter is before the Michigan Administrative Hearing System upon Petitioner's request for hearing made pursuant to MCL 400.9 and MCL 400.37, and Titles 7, 42, and 45 of the Code of Federal Regulations, which govern the administrative hearing and appeal process. After due notice, a telephone hearing was commenced on March 30, 2016, from Detroit, Michigan. The Petitioner was represented by the the Petitioner's Authorized Hearing Representative (AHR). The Department of Health and Human Services (Department) was represented by Specialist.

The hearing was requested to dispute the Department's action taken with respect to the Medical Assistance (MA) program benefits and to determine immigration status of the Petitioner. Shortly after commencement of the hearing, Petitioner or Petitioner's AHR testified that he/she now understood the actions taken by the Department which placed the Petitioner back on ESO in January 2016 due to her not having been in the United States for five (5) years and did not wish to proceed with the hearing. The Request for Hearing was withdrawn. The Department agreed to the dismissal of the hearing request.

Pursuant to the withdrawal of the hearing request filed in this matter, the Request for Hearing is, hereby, **DISMISSED**.
