ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This matter is before the Michigan Administrative Hearing System upon Petitioner's request for hearing made pursuant to MCL 400.9 and MCL 400.37, and Titles 7, 42, and 45 of the Code of Federal Regulations, which govern the administrative hearing and appeal process. After due notice, a telephone hearing was commenced on [REDACTED], [REDACTED] from Detroit, Michigan. The Petitioner was represented by [REDACTED], Authorized Hearing Representative (AHR). The Petitioner, [REDACTED], also appeared. A witness, [REDACTED], the Petitioner's mother, also appeared as a witness. The Department of Health and Human Services (Department) was represented by [REDACTED], Medical Contact Worker.

The hearing was requested to dispute the Department's action taken with respect to the State Disability Assistance (SDA) program benefits. Shortly after commencement of the hearing, the AHR testified that she now understood the actions taken by the Department and that Petitioner's application and medical documents had been sent to the Medical Review Team (MRT) and was pending their review and determination of disability. Based upon the fact that the MRT must determine disability before an application can be approved or denied and the matter was still pending, there was nothing for the undersigned Administrative Law Judge to determine at this time. Therefore, it is determined that the Petitioner's request for hearing dated [REDACTED], is hereby **DISMISSED**.
