**ORDER OF DISMISSAL PURSUANT TO PETITIONER'S
WITHDRAWAL OF REQUEST FOR HEARING**


Upon the request for a hearing by the Department of Health and Human Services (Department), this matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge pursuant to MCL 400.9, and in accordance with Titles 7, 42 and 45 of the Code of Federal Regulation (CFR), particularly 7 CFR 273.16 and 45 CFR 235.110; and with Mich Admin Code, R 400.3130 and 400.3178. After due notice, a telephone hearing was held on [REDACTED], from Detroit, Michigan. The Department was represented by [REDACTED], Regulation Agent of the Office of Inspector General (OIG). Respondent did not appear at the hearing; and it was held in Respondent's absence pursuant to 7 CFR 273.16(e), Mich Admin Code R 400.3130(5), or Mich Admin Code R 400.3178(5).

On [REDACTED], a hearing was requested by the Department regarding an Intentional Program Violation (IPV). Shortly after commencement of the hearing, it was discovered that the Department provided an improper address. Specifically, the Department originally provided the following last known address: 2916 E. Genesee Ave 1927, [REDACTED] MI 48601-4051." However, the Department indicated that "1927" should have not been included in the address and this was done in error. Since this State Emergency Relief (SER) issue pertained to an alleged IPV and/or overissuance, it is appropriate that a proper address be obtained to ensure due notice was given to the Respondent. Because Respondent did not receive due notice of the IPV hearing, the OIG agent requested to withdraw the request for disqualification hearing.

Based on the above information, the request for hearing (dated [REDACTED]) is **DISMISSED**.
