**ORDER OF DISMISSAL PURSUANT TO
WITHDRAWAL OF HEARING REQUEST AT HEARING**


This matter is before the Michigan Administrative Hearing System upon Petitioner's request for hearing made pursuant to MCL 400.9 and MCL 400.37, and Titles 7, 42, and 45 of the Code of Federal Regulations, which govern the administrative hearing and appeal process. After due notice, a telephone hearing was commenced on [REDACTED], from Detroit, Michigan. The Petitioner was represented by Petitioner. The Department of Health and Human Services (Department) was represented by [REDACTED], Hearings Facilitator. [REDACTED], acted as interpreter.

The hearing was requested to dispute the Department's action taken with respect to the Family Independence Program (FIP) benefits.
