### **HEARING DECISION**

Following Petitioner's request for a hearing, this matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge pursuant to MCL 400.9 and 400.37; 7 CFR 273.15 to 273.18; 42 CFR 431.200 to 431.250; 45 CFR 99.1 to 99.33; and 45 CFR 205.10; and Mich Admin Code, R 792.11002. After due notice, a telephone hearing was held on [REDACTED], from Detroit, Michigan. The Petitioner was represented by [REDACTED]. The Department of Health and Human Services (Department) was represented by [REDACTED], MRT Specialist.

### **ISSUE**

Did the Department properly reduce the Petitioner's Food Assistance Program (FAP) benefits?

### **FINDINGS OF FACT**

The Administrative Law Judge, based on the competent, material, and substantial evidence on the whole record, finds as material fact:

1. On [REDACTED], Department sent Petitioner a Simplified Six-Month Review, requesting various pieces of information.
2. On [REDACTED], Department sent the Petitioner a Notice of Case Action informing the Petitioner that her FAP benefits had been reduced and that her application for Family Independence Program (FIP) cash benefits had been denied.
3. [REDACTED], Petitioner requested a hearing by phone regarding her decreased FAP benefits.

### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Department policies are contained in the Department of Health and Human Services Bridges Administrative Manual (BAM), Department of Health and Human Services Bridges Eligibility Manual (BEM), Department of Health and Human Services Reference Tables Manual (RFT), and Department of Health and Human Services Emergency Relief Manual (ERM).

The Food Assistance Program (FAP) [formerly known as the Food Stamp program] is established by the Food and Nutrition Act of 2008, as amended, 7 USC 2011 to 2036a and is implemented by the federal regulations contained in 7 CFR 273. The Department (formerly known as the Department of Human Services) administers FAP pursuant to MCL 400.10, the Social Welfare Act, MCL 400.1-.119b, and Mich Admin Code, R 400.3001-.3011.

In this case, the Petitioner had been receiving \$ [REDACTED] a month in FAP benefits. Documentation from the Social Security Administration (SSA) shows that the Petitioner is in control of \$ [REDACTED] monthly, and this increase in income caused the decrease in the Petitioner's FAP benefits. (BEM 550, October 2015).


The undersigned ALJ reviewed the FAP budget provided by the Department with the Petitioner and finds it to be correct.

### DECISION AND ORDER

The Administrative Law Judge, based on the above Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, and for the reasons stated on the record, if any, finds that the Department acted in accordance with Department policy when it decreased the Petitioner's FAP benefits.

Accordingly, the Department's decision is **AFFIRMED**.
