ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Upon the Request for Hearing filed by the Department of Health and Human Services Office of Inspector General, this matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge pursuant to MCL 400.9, 400.43a and 24.201, *et seq.*; and in accordance with Titles 7, 42 and 45 of the code of Federal Regulations, particularly 7 CFR 273.16 and 45 CFR 235.110, and with Mich Admin Code R 400.3130 and R 400.3178. A hearing was scheduled for

Subsequent to the scheduling of the hearing and prior to the hearing date, the Notice of Disqualification Hearing that was mailed to Respondent at the last known address, and that constituted due notice, was returned to the Michigan Administrative Hearing System (MAHS) by the United States Postal Service as undeliverable.

Department policy dictates that when the Notice of Hearing concerning an Intentional Program Violation (IPV) is returned as undeliverable, the hearing cannot proceed except with respect to the Food Assistance Program (FAP). Department of Health and Human Services Bridges Administrative Manual (BAM) 720 (January 1, 2016), p. 1. Because the hearing concerned Family Independence Program (FIP) benefits, this hearing cannot proceed.

Accordingly, the request for a disqualification hearing is **DISMISSED**.
