**ORDER OF DISMISSAL PURSUANT TO  
WITHDRAWAL OF HEARING REQUEST AT HEARING**

This matter is before the Michigan Administrative Hearing System upon Petitioner's request for hearing made pursuant to MCL 400.9 and MCL 400.37, and Titles 7, 42, and 45 of the Code of Federal Regulations, which govern the administrative hearing and appeal process. After due notice, a telephone hearing was commenced on December 8, 2016, from Detroit, Michigan. The Petitioner was represented by [REDACTED], Petitioner; and his father/Authorized Hearing Representative (AHR), [REDACTED]. The Department of Health and Human Services (Department) was represented by [REDACTED], Hearings Facilitator.

On [REDACTED], the Department sent Petitioner a Health Care Coverage Determination Notice notifying him that his Medical Assistance (MA) – Healthy Michigan Plan (HMP) benefits would close effective [REDACTED]. Exhibit A, pp. 4-5.

As a result of the closure notice, on [REDACTED], Petitioner's AHR filed a hearing request, protesting the Department's action. Exhibit A, pp. 2-3.

Shortly after commencement of the hearing, it was discovered that Petitioner reapplied for MA benefits on [REDACTED]; and he was approved for HMP coverage effective [REDACTED]. This resulted in no lapse in coverage. As such, Petitioner's AHR did not wish to proceed with the hearing because the MA hearing issue had been resolved. The Request for Hearing was withdrawn. The Department agreed to the dismissal of the hearing request.

Pursuant to the withdrawal of the hearing request filed in this matter, the MA-HMP Request for Hearing (dated [REDACTED]) is, hereby, **DISMISSED**.
