HEARING DECISION

Following Petitioner's request for a hearing, this matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge pursuant to MCL 400.9 and 400.37; 7 CFR 273.15 to 273.18; 42 CFR 431.200 to 431.250; 45 CFR 99.1 to 99.33; and 45 CFR 205.10; and Mich Admin Code, R 792.11002. After due notice, a telephone hearing was held on [REDACTED], from Detroit, Michigan. The Petitioner was represented by [REDACTED]. The Department of Health and Human Services (Department) was represented by [REDACTED], Hearings Facilitator.

ISSUE

Did the Department properly close the Petitioner's Food Assistance Program (FAP) benefits effective [REDACTED]?

FINDINGS OF FACT

The Administrative Law Judge, based on the competent, material, and substantial evidence on the whole record, finds as material fact:

1. On [REDACTED], the Department sent the Petitioner a Redetermination Telephone Interview Notice for [REDACTED].
2. On [REDACTED] the Department sent the Petitioner a Verification Checklist requesting various pieces of documentation by [REDACTED].
3. On [REDACTED], the Department sent the Petitioner a Notice of Case Action informing her that her FAP benefits had been closed effective [REDACTED].

4. On [REDACTED], Petitioner requested a hearing to protest the closure of her FAP benefits.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Department policies are contained in the Department of Health and Human Services Bridges Administrative Manual (BAM), Department of Health and Human Services Bridges Eligibility Manual (BEM), Department of Health and Human Services Reference Tables Manual (RFT), and Department of Health and Human Services Emergency Relief Manual (ERM).

The Food Assistance Program (FAP) [formerly known as the Food Stamp program] is established by the Food and Nutrition Act of 2008, as amended, 7 USC 2011 to 2036a and is implemented by the federal regulations contained in 7 CFR 273. The Department (formerly known as the Department of Human Services) administers FAP pursuant to MCL 400.10, the Social Welfare Act, MCL 400.1-.119b, and Mich Admin Code, R 400.3001-.3011.

In this case, at the hearing, the Petitioner testified that she had provided the requested documentation for the redetermination.

There was no evidence provided to show that the Petitioner provided the requested information in a timely manner.


The undersigned ALJ finds that the Department was correct in closing the Petitioner's FAP benefits due to her failure to provide the requested verifications. (BAM 130, July 2016).

DECISION AND ORDER

The Administrative Law Judge, based on the above Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, and for the reasons stated on the record, if any, finds that the Department acted in accordance with Department policy when it closed the Petitioner's FAP benefits.

Accordingly, the Department's decision is **AFFIRMED**.
