**ORDER OF DISMISSAL PURSUANT TO  
WITHDRAWAL OF HEARING REQUEST AT HEARING**

This matter is before the Michigan Administrative Hearing System upon Petitioner's request for hearing made pursuant to MCL 400.9 and MCL 400.37, and Titles 7, 42, and 45 of the Code of Federal Regulations, which govern the administrative hearing and appeal process. After due notice, a telephone hearing was commenced on February 25, 2016, from Detroit, Michigan. The Petitioner was represented by Petitioner [REDACTED]. The Department of Health and Human Services (Department) was represented by [REDACTED], Eligibility Specialist.


The hearing was requested to dispute the Department's action taken with respect to the closure of the Petitioner's Food Assistance Program (FAP) and Medical Assistance (MA) Program and the Medicare Savings Program benefits. Shortly after commencement of the hearing, Petitioner testified that she now understood the actions taken by the Department closing these benefits had been reversed and the FAP, MA and Medicare Savings program benefits had been reinstated and did not wish to proceed with the hearing. The Request for Hearing was withdrawn. The Department agreed to the dismissal of the hearing request.

Pursuant to the withdrawal of the hearing request filed in this matter, the Request for Hearing is, hereby, **DISMISSED**.
