HEARING DECISION

Following Petitioner's request for a hearing, this matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge pursuant to MCL 400.9 and 400.37; 7 CFR 273.15 to 273.18; 42 CFR 431.200 to 431.250; 45 CFR 99.1 to 99.33; and 45 CFR 205.10; and Mich Admin Code, R 792.11002. After due notice, a telephone hearing was held on October 27, 2016, from Lansing, Michigan. Petitioner and her Community Mental Health worker [REDACTED] appeared and testified. The Department was represented by Eligibility Specialist [REDACTED]. Department's Exhibit A, pages 1-12 was admitted into evidence.

ISSUE

Did the Department properly deny Petitioner's State Emergency Relief (SER) application for Home Repairs?

FINDINGS OF FACT

The Administrative Law Judge, based on the competent, material, and substantial evidence on the whole record, finds as material fact:

1. On August 30, 2016, Petitioner submitted a State Emergency Relief (SER) application for Home Repair services.
2. Petitioner has a monthly mortgage expense of \$ [REDACTED] and a monthly income of \$ [REDACTED].
3. On August 31, 2016, Petitioner was sent a State Emergency Relief Decision Notice (DHS-1419) which stated her application was denied because her shelter was not affordable.
4. On September 23, 2016, Petitioner submitted a hearing request.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Department policies are contained in the Department of Health and Human Services Bridges Administrative Manual (BAM), Department of Health and Human Services Bridges Eligibility Manual (BEM), Department of Health and Human Services Reference Tables Manual (RFT), and Department of Health and Human Services Emergency Relief Manual (ERM).

The State Emergency Relief (SER) program is established by the Social Welfare Act, MCL 400.1-.119b. The SER program is administered by the Department (formerly known as the Department of Human Services) pursuant to MCL 400.10 and Mich Admin Code, R 400.7001-.7049.

State Emergency Relief Manual 207 Housing Affordability provides that housing affordability is a condition of eligibility for home repair services. The affordability calculation provides that a group's maximum total housing obligation cannot be more than 75% of their net countable income.


Petitioner testified that her son pays her mortgage payment. Petitioner's son is not a member of her household so his income is not included in the affordability calculation to determine Petitioner's eligibility for State Emergency Relief (SER) Home Repair services.

The Administrative Law Judge, based on the above Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, and for the reasons stated on the record, if any, finds that the Department acted in accordance with Department policy when it denied Petitioner's State Emergency Relief (SER) application for Home Repairs.

DECISION AND ORDER

Accordingly, the Department's decision is **AFFIRMED**.
