HEARING DECISION

Following Petitioner's request for a hearing, this matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge pursuant to MCL 400.9 and 400.37; 7 CFR 273.15 to 273.18; 42 CFR 431.200 to 431.250; 45 CFR 99.1 to 99.33; and 45 CFR 205.10; and Mich Admin Code, R 792.11002. After due notice, a telephone hearing was held on March 1, 2017, from Lansing, Michigan. Petitioner personally appeared and testified.

The Department of Health and Human Services (Department) was represented by Assistance Payment Supervisor, **Section 1**, and Eligibility Specialist, **Section 1**, and **Section 1**

Regulations governing the hearing and appeal process for applicants and recipients of public assistance in Michigan are found in Mich Admin Code, R 792.10101 to R 792.10137 and R 792.11001 to R 792.11020. Rule 792.11002(1) provides as follows:

An opportunity for a hearing shall be granted to an applicant who requests a hearing because his or her claim for assistance is denied or is not acted upon with reasonable promptness, has received notice of a suspension or reduction in benefits, or exclusion from a service program, or has experienced a failure of the agency to take into account the recipient's choice of service.

In this case, Petitioner had not been denied Medicaid benefits, nor had she received a notice of suspension or reduction in benefits.

Under the administrative rule discussed above, Petitioner does not have a right to a hearing because Petitioner had not received a negative action concerning her Medicaid. Thus, this Administrative Law Judge has no jurisdiction in this matter.

As a result, Petitioner's hearing request is **HEREBY DISMISSED** for lack of jurisdiction.
