ORDER OF DISMISSAL PURSUANT TO WITHDRAWAL OF HEARING REQUEST AT HEARING

This matter is before the Michigan Administrative Hearing System upon Petitioner's request for hearing made pursuant to MCL 400.9 and MCL 400.37, and Titles 7, 42, and 45 of the Code of Federal Regulations, which govern the administrative hearing and appeal process. After due notice, a telephone hearing commenced on **Mathematical Regulations**, from **Mathematical Regulations**, Petitioner, appeared on her own behalf. The Department of Health and Human Services (Department) was represented by **Mathematical Regulator**.

The hearing was requested to dispute the Department's action taken with respect to the Medicaid (MA) program benefits. Shortly after commencement of the hearing, the Hearing Facilitator confirmed that the contested MA eligibility issue has been resolved. Petitioner now has full MA coverage for the time period at issue, through **Coverage**. Further, the Department has approved a 12 month billing exception. Accordingly, Petitioner withdrew the MA eligibility portion of her hearing request on the record¹. The Department agreed to the dismissal based on Petitioner's withdrawal on the record.

Pursuant to the withdrawal of the hearing request filed in this matter, the MA eligibility portion of Petitioner's Request for Hearing is, hereby, **DISMISSED**.


