ORDER GRANTING ADJOURNMENT

Upon the Request for Hearing filed by the Department of Health and Human Services Office of Inspector General, this matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge pursuant to MCL 400.9, 400.43a and 24.201, *et seq.*; and in accordance with Titles 7, 42 and 45 of the code of Federal Regulations, particularly 7 CFR 273.16 and 45 CFR 235.110, and with Rules 111 and 1003 of the Michigan Administrative Hearing System Uniform Hearing Rules, Mich Admin Code, R 792.10111 and R 792.11003. At the hearing, the Department was represented by [REDACTED], Lead Agent with the Office of Inspector General (OIG). Respondent did not appear at the scheduled hearing, and it was commenced in Respondent's absence pursuant to 7 CFR 273.16(e) and Mich Admin Code R 792.10134.

The Department requested a hearing alleging that Respondent committed an intentional program violation (IPV). The Michigan Administrative Hearing System (MAHS) sent Respondent notice of the IPV hearing at the [REDACTED] address identified by the OIG in its hearing request. On the scheduled hearing date, the OIG agent testified that she had recently become aware that Respondent had moved back to Michigan and provided an updated address. Because Respondent potentially did not receive notice of the IPV hearing and a more current address was available at the scheduled hearing date, the hearing was adjourned so that notice could be provided to Respondent at the updated addresses, as identified herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that this hearing is hereby **ADJOURNED** and will be rescheduled for hearing with notice provided to parties in accordance with applicable law and policy.
