HEARING DECISION

Following Petitioner's request for a hearing, this matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge pursuant to MCL 400.9 and 400.37; 7 CFR 273.15 to 273.18; 42 CFR 431.200 to 431.250; 45 CFR 99.1 to 99.33; and 45 CFR 205.10. After due notice, a telephone hearing was held on December 18, 2018, from Lansing, Michigan. Petitioner represented herself. The Department of Health and Human Services was represented by Deann Jordan and Karina Littles.

ISSUE

Did the Department of Health and Human Services (Department) properly denied Petitioner's Food Assistance Program (FAP) application?

FINDINGS OF FACT

The Administrative Law Judge, based on the competent, material, and substantial evidence on the whole record, finds as material fact:

1. On [REDACTED] [REDACTED] 2018, the Department received Petitioner's application for Food Assistance Program (FAP) benefits.
2. On October 2, 2018, the Department sent Petitioner a Verification Checklist (DHS-3503).
3. On October 19, 2018, the Department notified Petitioner that her Food Assistance Program (FAP) application had been denied.
4. On [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] the Department received Petitioner's request for a hearing protesting the denial of her Food Assistance Program (FAP) application.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Department policies are contained in the Department of Health and Human Services Bridges Administrative Manual (BAM), Department of Health and Human Services Bridges Eligibility Manual (BEM), Department of Health and Human Services Reference Tables Manual (RFT), and Department of Health and Human Services Emergency Relief Manual (ERM).

The Food Assistance Program (FAP) [formerly known as the Food Stamp program] is established by the Food and Nutrition Act of 2008, as amended, 7 USC 2011 to 2036a and is implemented by the federal regulations contained in 7 CFR 273. The Department (formerly known as the Department of Human Services) administers FAP pursuant to MCL 400.10, the Social Welfare Act, MCL 400.1-.119b, and Mich Admin Code, R 400.3001-.3011.

An interview is required before denying FAP assistance even if it is clear from the application or other sources that the group is ineligible. Department of Health and Human Services Bridges Administrative Manual (BAM) 115 (October 1, 2018), p 19.


On September 19, 2018, the Department received Petitioner's FAP application. On November 14, 2018, Petitioner had not participated in the required eligibility interview and the Department notified her that her application had been denied.

The Administrative Law Judge, based on the above Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, and for the reasons stated on the record, if any, finds that the Department acted in accordance with Department policy when it denied Petitioner's Food Assistance Program (FAP) application for failing to participate in a required eligibility interview.

DECISION AND ORDER

Accordingly, the Department's decision is AFFIRMED.
