Dear Mr. Aloma:

The Michigan Office of Administrative Hearings and Rules (MOAHR) received your letter dated December 27, 2019 in which you request that “the court . . . obligate [the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS)] to respect orders from Administrative hearing.”

A review of the MOAHR files shows that on November 15, 2019, Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) [REDACTED] issued a Hearing Decision ordering DHHS to reprocess your September 6, 2019 application for Food Assistance Program (FAP), Medicaid (MA), and State Emergency Relief (SER) benefits. Further review of the MOAHR files shows that, after the Decision was issued, DHHS activated your MA coverage and began issuing FAP benefits to you. Therefore, it appears that the MA and FAP issues have been resolved.

Although the MOAHR files show that the reprocessing of the SER application was pending, you included with your letter to MOAHR a SER Decision Notice DHHS sent you on November 22, 2019. Because that notice was dated after the November 15, 2019 Hearing Decision, it indicates that DHHS reprocessed your application and took a new action concerning the SER application. If you dispute that action, you are required to request a hearing in accordance with Department policy.

Thank you for bringing your concerns to our attention. We appreciate having had the opportunity to serve you.
