The Michigan Administrative Hearing System (MAHS) is in receipt of your August 28, 2018 letter concerning the implementation of the Hearing Decision issued August 13, 2018 in which the Administrative Law Judge found that you had committed an intentional program violation and imposed a 12-month disqualification from your participation in the Food Assistance Program (FAP). In your letter, you express concerns about the Department of Health and Human Services' failure to timely impose the FAP disqualification.
