On July 26, 2018, the Michigan Administrative Hearing System (MAHS) received your fax expressing concerns that the Department of Health and Human Services (Department) failed to implement the June 22, 2018 Hearing Decision issued by Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) [REDACTED]. In the Hearing Decision, ALJ [REDACTED] concluded that the Department had failed to present sufficient evidence to explain its conclusion that you were not income-eligible for Medicaid coverage under the Freedom to Work (FTW) program, and she ordered that the Department redetermine your eligibility from June 1, 2018 ongoing.

In your letter, you state that the Department has not fixed your Medicaid case. We appreciate you forwarding your concerns to our attention. Unfortunately, once the Hearing Decision is issued, MAHS no longer has the authority to address enforcement or implementation of the decision. However, I will forward your letter to the Department's Lansing Field Operations Division for further review and assistance.
