ORDER DENYING REQUEST TO VACATE DISMISSAL

On August 3, 2018, Petitioner, [REDACTED] submitted to the Michigan Administrative Hearing System a request to vacate the Order of Dismissal issued July 12, 2018 relative to the hearing scheduled on July 11, 2018. In her request, Petitioner indicates that she was unable to attend the hearing because of her angina. However, the medical evidence Petitioner presented in connection with her request shows that she went to the DMC on July 18, 2018, a week after her hearing date, and a review of the MAHS records for Petitioner's case does not show that Petitioner called MAHS prior to the hearing time to explain that she was unable to attend the hearing because of illness.

The undersigned Supervising Administrative Law Judge, having reviewed the request to vacate, and having found no good cause exists to vacate the Order of Dismissal,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the request is **DENIED**.
