The Michigan Administrative Hearing System (MAHS) is in receipt of your fax dated October 8, 2018. In your fax you express concerns about the failure of the Department of Health and Human Services (Department) to implement the order in the Hearing Decision issued on September 10, 2018 by Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) [REDACTED] in connection with your case under MAHS docket no. 18-007637. In the Hearing Decision, ALJ [REDACTED] concluded that the Department had improperly closed your Family Independence Program (FIP) case, and he ordered the Department to reinstate your case effective July 2018.

In your letter, you state that the worker at the Department's local office has refused to implement ALJ [REDACTED] order. Unfortunately, after ALJ [REDACTED] issued his decision on September 10, 2018, MAHS has no further authority with respect to the Department's actions to implement the decision. However, in an attempt to have your concerns addressed, we are forwarding your complaint and concerns to the Department's field services operations in Lansing for further investigation of the local office's actions. We hope that this will result in resolution of your concerns.
