Dear Mr. Shotey:

The Michigan Office of Administrative Hearings and Rules (MOAHR) is in receipt of your fax dated July 30, 2019. In your fax you express concerns about the failure of the Department of Health and Human Services (Department) to implement the order in the May 31, 2019 Hearing Decision issued by Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) [REDACTED] in connection with your case under MAHS docket no. 19-004424. In the Hearing Decision, ALJ [REDACTED] concluded that the Department had improperly closed your Medicare Savings Program (MSP) case, and she ordered the Department to reprocess your MSP eligibility and, if you are eligible, to issue supplements in accordance with Department policy.

Although MOAHR has no authority with respect to the Department's actions once the decision is issued, I have forwarded your concerns to the Department's field services operation for further investigation. It is my understanding that the local office will be able to assist you in this matter. If you find that this issue is not satisfactorily resolved, you are advised that you may request a hearing to dispute the July 29, 2019 Health Care Coverage Determination attached to your fax or any other action made by the Department after the May 31, 2019 Hearing Decision was issued.
