ORDER OF DISMISSAL PURSUANT TO WITHDRAWAL OF HEARING REQUEST AT HEARING

This matter is before the Michigan Office of Administrative Hearings and Rules upon Petitioner's request for hearing made pursuant to MCL 400.9 and MCL 400.37, and Titles 7, 42, and 45 of the Code of Federal Regulations, which govern the administrative hearing and appeal process. After due notice, a telephone hearing was commenced on June 13, 2019, from Detroit, Michigan. Petitioner was represented by agent of generative (AHR). The Department of Health and Human Services (Department) was represented by generative, Hearings Facilitator.

The AHR requested a hearing to dispute the Department's failure to process Petitioner's application for Medicare Savings Program (MSP) benefits. After the Department explained the actions it had taken following receipt of the AHR's hearing request on May 1, 2019, the AHR testified that she now agreed that the Department had resolved the issue for which a hearing was requested, and she did not wish to proceed with the hearing. The Request for Hearing was withdrawn. The Department agreed to the dismissal of the hearing request.
