The Michigan Office of Administrative Hearings and Rules (MOAHR) received your fax dated October 7, 2019 in which you express concerns about the failure of the Department of Health and Human Services (Department) to implement the order in the August 21, 2019 Hearing Decision issued by Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) in connection with your case under MOAHR docket no. 19-004831. In the Hearing Decision, ALJ concluded that you are disabled and the Department had improperly denied your application for State Disability Assistance (SDA) benefits based on its finding that you were not disabled.

MOAHR has no authority with respect to the Department's actions once the decision is issued. However, if the Department has taken an action that you do not agree with or that you believe is inconsistent with the ALJ's order, you have the right to request a new hearing on that matter. Additionally, I have forwarded your concerns to the Department's field services operation for further investigation and, hopefully, resolution.
