On September 9, 2019, the Michigan Office of Administrative Hearings and Rules (MOAHR) received your letter requesting an appeal of the hearing decision by Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) [REDACTED]. In a July 1, 2019 decision, ALJ [REDACTED] concluded that the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) properly determined your Medicaid eligibility. You requested reconsideration and/or rehearing of the matter. In Orders dated July 25, 2019 and August 29, 2019, ALJ [REDACTED] concluded that you had not established a basis for rehearing and/or reconsideration.

At this time, your administrative remedies with MOAHR have been exhausted.
