AMENDED ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On August 15, 2019, the Michigan Office of Administrative Hearings and Rules (MOAHR) issued an Order of Dismissal in the above-referenced matter due to the failure of Petitioner [REDACTED] or his authorized hearing representative (AHR) to participate in the hearing scheduled on August 14, 2019. On August 19, 2019, MOAHR received a request from the Department of Health and Human Services (Department) that MOAHR reschedule the hearing because the Department failed to call in for the hearing at the scheduled time. Before an order was issued in response to the Department's request, Petitioner's AHR submitted a withdrawal of Petitioner's hearing request.

The undersigned has reviewed the hearing request withdrawal and, finding it consistent with policy and statutory requirements as found in the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR); 7 CFR 273.15(l); 42 CFR 431.22(a) and 45 CFR 205.10(a), and Bridges Administrative Manual (BAM) 600, has approved the withdrawal of Petitioner's hearing request.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

The August 15, 2019 Order of Dismissal is amended to show that the dismissal is due to Petitioner's AHR's withdrawal of the hearing request.
