The Michigan Office of Administrative Hearings and Rules (MOAHR) received your September 23, 2019 fax expressing concerns that the Department of Health of Human Services (DHHS) failed to process your January 9, 2019 application for Family Independence Program (FIP) benefits in accordance with an August 17, 2019 hearing decision.

While MOAHR does not have any authority over DHHS's reprocessing of the application, a review of the MOAHR records shows that DHHS certified to MOAHR that it had reprocessed the January 9, 2019 application and prepared a notice of its decision to be sent to you. If you received such a notice and dispute the outcome, you may request a hearing. I will also forward your concerns to DHHS's field services for further review.
