ORDER DENYING HEARING REQUEST WITHDRAWAL
AND
ORDER OF DISMISSAL FOR FAILURE TO APPEAR

The undersigned supervising Administrative Law Judge reviewed the hearing request withdrawal signed and submitted by Petitioner [REDACTED] to the Michigan Office of Administrative Hearings and Rules (MOAHR). A review of the MOAHR records show that when Petitioner submitted his hearing request, he appointed an authorized hearing representative (AHR). Because the hearing request withdrawal was signed by Petitioner, not the AHR, it was not properly authorized. See Bridges Administrative Manual (BAM) 600 (July 2019), p. 29. Neither Petitioner nor the AHR appeared at and participated in the hearing scheduled on August 19, 2019.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that, because the withdrawal was not signed by the AHR, the request for withdrawal is **DENIED**;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, because neither Petitioner nor the AHR appeared at the hearing scheduled on August 19, 2019, Petitioner's hearing is **DISMISSED**.
