The Michigan Office of Administrative Hearings and Rules (MOAHR) received your fax dated December 17, 2019 referencing MOAHR docket no. 19-009801. The administrative law judge who conducted the hearing under docket no. 19-009801 issued a Decision finding that the Department of Health and Human Services had properly denied your application for State Disability Assistance (SDA) benefits. The MOAHR files show that you requested a rehearing and/or reconsideration of that Decision, and in a December 6, 2019 Order, your request was denied.

At this time, your administrative remedies with MOAHR under docket nos. 19-009801 and 19-009801-Recon have been exhausted. Any appeal that you wish to take must be to circuit court, as provided in the "Notice of Appeal" at the bottom of the Order Denying Request for Rehearing and/or Reconsideration, a copy of which is attached for your convenience.
