On December 13, 2019, the Michigan Office of Administrative Hearings and Rules (MOAHR) received your letter expressing concerns about the failure by the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) to comply with the Hearing Decision issued November 25, 2019. In the Decision, the administrative law judge ordered DHHS to recalculate your Food Assistance Program (FAP) benefits after giving you the opportunity to verify your gas expenses.

A review of the MOAHR records shows that DHHS certified to MOAHR on December 2, 2019 that it had recalculated your FAP budget and determined that you continued to be eligible for only \$16 in monthly FAP benefits. In your letter, you acknowledge receipt of a Notice of Case Action (Notice) dated December 4, 2019 notifying you of the recalculated FAP benefit amount. Because this Notice was issued after the November 25, 2019 Hearing Decision, it is a new action by DHHS. If you dispute DHHS's recalculated FAP benefits amount you may request a new hearing at this time, in accordance with Department policy.
