The Michigan Office of Administrative Hearings and Rules (MOAHR) received your fax dated December 30, 2019 in which you express concerns about the failure of the Department of Health and Human Services (Department) to implement the order in the December 12, 2019 Hearing Decision issued by Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) ██████████ ██████████ in connection with your case under MOAHR docket no. 19-011685. In the Hearing Decision, ALJ ██████████ found that the Department had failed to show that it properly closed your Medicaid (MA) case and ordered the Department to reinstate your MA case under the Healthy Michigan Plan and timely notify you of any future changes to your MA case after giving you the opportunity to clarify information.

Unfortunately, once the ALJ's decision is issue, MOAHR has no further authority with respect to your case. However, I have forwarded your concerns to the Department's Field Operations and have been advised that your MA case was reinstated and that the local office has sent you notice of the reinstatement.

If you continue to have concerns about the handling of your MA case, you may file a new request for hearing disputing the Department's current action at the local office in accordance with Department policy.
